

## MINI TAKES THE STATES DAY 9 - AUGUST 29 - NASHVILLE, TN to ST. LOUIS, MO



**Total Daily Drive Time:** 5 hours or 310 miles

**Departure Time:** 8:00am – 10:00 am

**Departure Location:** Centennial Park – 2600 West End Ave.

**Estimated Arrival into St. Louis:** 1:00pm - 3:00pm

**Main Route Directions:** Interstate 24 into Kentucky and Illinois to Interstate 57 North to Interstate 64 East into St. Louis. Driving through the cities of: Nashville, Cadiz, Paducah, Metropolis, Mount Vernon and St. Louis.

**Main Route Synopsis:** Stop by the morning departure desk Centennial Park (2600 West End Ave) between the hours of 8am and 10am to receive information and details on the day's drive and the upcoming stop.

From Nashville, today's drive takes you over lakes, rivers, bridges and through some pretty scenic territory. Four states in four hours, now that's motoring. Today you'll experience Tennessee, Kentucky, Illinois and finally you'll find out why they call it the Show Me State in Missouri. Crossing the Mississippi River from Illinois into St. Louis gives you one of the most spectacular views in the heartland, the Gateway Arch and the St. Louis skyline. The Gateway Arch, designed by Finnish architect Eero Saarinen stands over 630 feet tall and is the tallest habitable structure in the city. Take the tram to the observation deck and you might even feel it sway with the wind. Just don't look down!

**Arrival Desk:** For your convenience, the arrival desk in St. Louis will be located at the Tailgate Party parking lot (adjacent to the Westin Hotel). The arrival desk will be open from 5:30 pm – 7:30 pm.

**Special Events: MINI Tailgate Party - Cardinals vs. Marlins:** We can't go across the USA without participating in one of America's greatest pastimes - Baseball! The Tailgate parking lot is located 300 South 10th St., St. Louis, MO 63102 (next to The Westin St. Louis). Parking near the event and stadium ranges in price from \$10.00 - \$20.00 dollars, either leave your car at your hotel and walk, or we suggest a lot at 421 S. 10th St. Parking in this lot is \$12.00 for the evening.

Since then tickets have been selling very quickly as with all baseball franchises who unveil a new stadium. If you plan to attend the game in person, please purchase your tickets as soon as possible to avoid disappointment and sold out status. The game most likely will sell out.

The entire game will be broadcast live via satellite during the Cardinals vs. Marlins tailgate party. If you prefer to watch the game from inside the stadium, please purchase your individual tickets via the St. Louis Cardinals official website ([stlouis.cardinals.mlb.com](http://stlouis.cardinals.mlb.com)) or charge by phone at (314) 345-9000 from 9am - 9pm CST, 7 days per week. If you live in the St. Louis metropolitan area, tickets may be purchased in person at Busch Stadium box office during normal business hours or at the following Cardinals Clubhouse Stores: St. Louis Galleria, Union Station and St. Clair Square. Tickets are also available through Schnucks Video Clubs.

**Off the Beaten Path:** This route; Interstate 24 into Kentucky exiting near Cadiz, KY to Land Between the Lakes region of Kentucky. Take I-14 West to Clarsville, TN and Dover, TN. Via TN-76 or Exit 11. Just after Dover, TN, turn right onto The Trace traveling North through Land Between the Lakes National Recreation area. There are numerous attractions within this region, some fees may apply. The Trace is considered by many as one of the most scenic driving roads in the region. You'll want to continue driving North towards Interstate 24 and Metropolis, IL., finally heading back on the main route to St. Louis.
